


4. VISA

Most ASEAN country could enter Indonesia without Visa, another participants has to apply Visa in their respective country, or you can use Visa on arrival (at Jakarta or Bali airport mostly overseas flight stop those two airports) and the requirement using Visa on arrival:

- a. Please make sure Passport valid until next 6 month from the arrival.
- b. Pay Visa on Arrival administration (35 USD) or ± Rp. 525.000,-

5. ACCOMMODATION

For reasons of safety and convenience, we recommended that all participants check in Prama Sanur Beach Hotel. There is no need to book a room at Prama Sanur Beach Hotel. Enough rooms will be made available for all participants in advance.

- a. Deluxe room – IDN Rp 1,500,000 (USD 100.00)
Facilities: Room size: 32 mtr², 1 king size double bed (2 meter – width bed) or 2 twin bed; free internet, free breakfast, and private balcony.
- b. Superior room – IDN Rp 1,400,000 (USD 93.00)
Facilities: room size: 25 mtr², 1 king size double bed (2 meter – width bed) or 2 twin bed; free internet, free breakfast, and private balcony.

6. TRANSPORTATION

Airport Transportation

7. OTHER INFORMATION

a. Electricity:

The standard voltage in Indonesia is 220 V / 50 Hz. Indonesia holds standard socket of 2-round pins plug without a ground pin (Type A). Participants are recommended to bring their own adaptors to comply with electric current and plugs.



b. Currency: The local currency is Indonesian Rupiah (IDR). Participants can exchange foreign currencies at available services at Ngurah Rai International Airport, shopping venues, and recreational sites throughout the city. USD 1 = IDR 15.200 (as of Oct 29, 2018).

c. Climate: The local temperature during September in Bali is as predicted below. February Weather Averages for Bali, Indonesia.

1) Temperature

The weather in Bali in February is very similar to what it is in January. The average temperature remains the same this month, at 26°C (79°F), while the average low is 22°C (72°F), and the average high comes in at 30°C (86°F). Similarly to January, the weather this month does not vary much from beginning to end.

At the start of February, the average daily temperature is 27°C (81°F), with overcast skies and a decent chance of rain, when the sun isn't shining. The middle of the month is more of the same, with the average daily temperature slightly rising to 27.5°C (81.5°F), before rounding out the end of the month with a daily average of 28°C (82°C), and again a high chance of rain. The lowest ever recorded temperature for the month of February was 22°C (72°F), while the highest ever was 37°C (97°F).

2) Rain and Sunshine

As February is part of Bali's "wet season," the average daily sunshine is just six hours per day this month. Although the sun is out for a short time each day this month, this doesn't mean that it's constantly raining, as even on days when rainfall does occur, storms can quickly clear and bring out the sun. Rainfall is common in February though, as there is an average of 90mm this month, occurring over more than half of the days, at 15 of the 28.

3) Sea Temperatures

Also similarly to January is the warm temperature of the sea this month. February is tied with January for the warmest average sea temperature in Bali at 29°C (84°F). This is very warm water that anyone would be comfortable swimming in, even for extended periods of time.

4) Humidity

The humidity levels in February are quite high, with the average level for the month being 80%. Even without high temperatures this is an uncomfortable level, but when mixed with temperatures that routinely go above 30°C (86°F) in February, it becomes even worse.
